FROM THE SECRETARY'S DESK

ith deepest condolance to the deaparted Soul of our Honble' Central Committee (Existing) Member Shri Ujjal Dasgupta, our honble' boarders Mrs. Chabi Dhar & Mrs. Baby Paul of नजून विकाना - a home for Elderly People during the last & present years, Bengali Vaidya Samaj Jadavpur is on it's 6th year of journey aiming with a mission to help the deprived and poor, helpless people of the society irrespective of any caste and creed; although the membership of our organisation is restricted within the Vaidyas' by birth or by marriage.

As we know that BVSJ started their dream, a NON PROFIT project named "Notun Thikana a Home for Elderly People" at Boro Kathalia, Barrackpore in the month of November 2019 by execution of a lease agreement and on monthly rental basis for the willfull elder borders as well as for the destitute elders of the society as well (70:30).

Due to worldwide pandamic situation alongwith restless negetive marketing by few of our existing (comittee / general) members via social media and among our honble' members caused huge financial crisis and finally compelled us to SHUT DOWN the project from 31/12/2020. Although we sheltered Mrs. Rama Das (70) of Let us keep doing a bit by each of us to make Barrackpore for a week and sent back to her family who came to us via Titagarh Police. Mrs. Nilima Acharjee - a 65 year old lady rescued by the Panchayet Member Shri Chandu Sing- EVERYTHING ... Swamiji. haroy and handed over to us on 26/01/2020 and handed over to us. She had been sent back to her son after three months with the help of Haringhata P.S.

Mrs. Baby Paul (75) had been rescued from Nona Chandanpukur by the Titagarh Police and handed over to us in the month of January 20. She passed away at B.N. Bose Hospital on 05/03/21. Before that BVSJ took every care of that destitute lady in terms of food, shelter, medicines and all other necesary articles and thankful to al the donors who helped us to feed those destitutes. We also performed the rituals in memory of Baby Pal on 14th instant.

As and when we received information from any source, We tried to reach almost each and every family who were income less and were facing financial crunch to have their daily eateries, ration etc. during Covid 19 Lock Down, directly or via other volunteers / departments and provided them ration, medicines, masks, sanitizers etc. as per requirement. We also extended our member Mrs. Soma Dasgupta (Roy), the help, assistance to about 150 Families altogether during this period We provided rations, food items to 25 families affected by Amphan Storm at Kultali, 24 Parganas(south).

> Have organized a **Blood Donation** camp and Pre-Covid Test camp, provided food, snacks, masks etc. to the destitute childrens time to time and Winter Garments provided to 50 destitutes Kalyani station even after the crysis.

> We have tied up AMRI Hospitals group along with existing hospitals this year from where our members may avail financial discount/s and whenever they required. care

> We felicitated several ladies from the different sector of the society by celebrating International Women's Day and for all those activities. I am thankful to all the members of BVSJ, other organizations, donors, volunteers and all other person/s organization/s who helped us to reach the goal. I personally believe that if we become united, we can achieve several goals like that. If we are able to gather all vaidyas' across the world and each family donate a sum of Rs. 100/- per month, we may take care of thousands of needy people.

We pay our homage to the departed souls and convey our heartfelt deep condolences for the bereaved family members. Bengali Vaidya Samaj will remember you forever.




